IN INDIA AND ABROAD



- Three Pre-University Colleges with vocational courses and first Grade College catering to needs of rural suburbs of Bangalore, at Bommasandra Village, Banashankari and Mysore, India 1981-2007
- Industrial Training Institute—started in 1982 at Malkote, moved to Bommasandra Village Campus, Bangalore, India in 1986.
- Started a Rural Health Clinic & Maternity Hospital at Chandrappa Circle (Serving about 40 Villages), Magadi TK, India 1984 & 1994
- Instituted Rs. 6,000,000 Endowment to provide 100 annual scholarships to needy students, India 1987-2006
- Polytechnic Institute—started in 1987 at Bommasandra, Bangalore, India
- Contributed approximately \$50,000 towards 20+ world community service projects abroad and completed them in collaboration with Rotary International 1989-2006
- Instituted Rs. 1,50,000 endowment at Kannada Sahitya Parishat to provide annual award and publication of best literary work from a rural area since 1994, in India
- Started Engineering Degree College at Bommasandra Village Campus—1997
- Started three Vidyavahini Schools (primary/secondary) in rural parts of Bangalore & Mysore, India since 1995
- Contributed \$5,000 for the "Home for the Aged" project at Warangal, Andhra Pradesh, India—1999
- Started Nursing School, B.Ed. College, and D.Ed. College at Bommasandra Campus 2004-2007.

SERVICE PROJECTS

IN THE U.S.



- Contributed \$65,000 to the Ministry of Caring toward the full purchase price for three buildings for Home for Homeless/Transitional Shelters in Wilmington, DE—2000
- Provide Holiday Meals to the needy every year since 1986
- Instituted \$60,000 endowment at University of Delaware to provide annual scholarships to needy engineering students since 1990
- Contributed \$3,500 in scholarships to Delaware Technical and Community College, Newark, DE—1997
- Adopt-A-Highway Cleaning Program since 1995 in Delaware
- Served over 39,000 free Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day and Meals on Wheels dinners to the needy in Delaware, Pennsylvania, Maryland and New Jersey since 1986. During 2005-2006 alone, 1,500 holiday dinners were served and 110 Turkey Baskets were distributed
- Sponsored Blind Artist Group of SRMAB from India to perform in the USA and the proceeds of \$13,000 contributed to support rural needy projects of SRM Academy for the Blind.

Founder and Chairman Bangalore T. Lakshman has contributed over \$1,000,000 as of December 2005 toward the Foundation's projects.
